- 1) INTRODUCTION (1 John 2:4-9)
 - a) Those who are Heaven-born are Heaven-bound and bear certain traits or birthmarks.
 - b) If we do not bear these birthmarks, then we need to evaluate and ask ourselves if we have ever truly trusted Jesus as Lord.
