DAY 1

“The greatest problem we face is not unanswered prayer but unoffered prayer.”

ADRIAN ROGERS

...You do not have because you do not ask.

JAMES 4:2

DAY 2

“Pray when you feel like it. Pray when you don’t feel like it.”

ADRIAN ROGERS

Pray without ceasing.

1 THESSALONIANS 5:17

DAY 3

“You can do more than pray after you pray but you can do no more than pray until you pray.”

ADRIAN ROGERS

Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

JAMES 5:6

DAY 4

“Prayer is not bending God’s will to fit our will, but prayer is finding the will of God and getting in on it.”

Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

DAY 5

“When we pray for rain, we ought to carry an umbrella.”

DAY 6

“Your spiritual life will never rise above your prayer life.”

Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak..

“A lot of kneeling will keep you in good standing.”

ADRIAN ROGERS

Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my strength and my Redeemer.

PSALM 19:14

DAY 8

“Prayer is the greatest Christian privilege.”

ADRIAN ROGERS

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

HEBREWS 4:16

DAY 9

“Tragically, many of our prayers are so vague that if God were to answer them, we wouldn’t even know it.”

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.

“It’s not the length of the prayer but the depth that counts.”
