


# CASTING of the FLOWERS

# A IS FOR ALPHA.

***God was here in the beginning,

before all people and before you were born.***



“In the beginning God

**Devotional:** God was here first! He was here when there was nothing but darkness—before anything or anyone was created on this Earth. He always was here and always will be here. That’s hard to imagine, right? Some things we can’t understand, and this is definitely one of those things to ask God about one day in Heaven. Think about a world that was dark, without sunshine or trees or people. God brought it to life! The Bible tells us in Genesis 1 that God took great delight in His creation and called all that He made, “good,” with His most special part of creation being us... men, women, boys, and girls. You are special, and God has you on this Earth for a reason!

**Activity Suggestion:** Take a ball or hula hoop and toss it in the air to one another. Wherever your hand lands when you catch it, try to find the place on the ball or hula hoop where it starts and where it ends. Can you find it? No, because just like God, a circle has no beginning or end.

# B IS FOR BOUNDLESS.


***God has no out-of-bounds place He cannot be.  
He can be everywhere at once, including here with me.***

“The LORD looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of men.”

PSALM 33:13

**Devotional:** When you play tag with your friends or sports with your team, there are always rules. You have to stay within a certain space to play and not go out of bounds, right? Or when you travel to visit your grandparents or go on vacation with your family, you can only visit one place at a time. This is why thinking about God being boundless is so hard to understand! He can be EVERYWHERE at the same time. God has no out-of-bounds place; He has no limitations. If I traveled around the world to China and you stayed here, He would still be able to hear my prayers and your prayers at the SAME time! He holds the WHOLE WORLD IN HIS HANDS and can meet every need, because God is boundless.

**Activity Suggestion:** Learn the motions and sing “He’s Got the Whole World in His Hands” together. If you have a globe, spin and land your finger on a spot, and say, “No matter where I go in the world, God is there!”



# C IS FOR CREATOR.


***God is the great artist who makes every shape and color in the world. He forms the mountains, paints the sunsets, and makes every boy and girl.***

“For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth.”

COLOSSIANS 1:16A

**Devotional:** God made EVERYTHING! When you look around, you can see that God loves design and loves color. He made people in all different colors, shapes and sizes; He made trees, flowers and animals in all different colors, shapes and sizes. He is the FIRST original creator. All of the colors, materials and designs you see were originally designed by God first. Through the years, people have learned how to use those colors, materials and shapes to make other things, such the car you drive, the house you live in or the clothes you wear. God really is the GREAT God and the FIRST AND BEST Creator!

**Activity Suggestion:** Walk outside or look out the window. Point out as many different colors as you can in creation. Then move on to different shapes and sizes. Optional: Have a color and shape scavenger hunt outdoors. Start with the basic colors and shapes on a piece of paper and check them off as you find them, noting that this creation is God's.



# D IS FOR DAILY BREAD.

***Just as your body needs food to grow each and every day Even more, your heart needs spiritual food from the Bible and time to pray.***

“Man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every word that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.”

DEUTERONOMY 8:3B

**Devotional:** Your body cannot grow bigger and stronger if you don't eat, right? In this same way, if you want to grow to be more like the Lord, you have to spend time reading your Bible. The Bible is God's Word; reading it is how we learn more about Him. The more time you spend in God's Word, the stronger your relationship with Him will grow. And when you have a relationship with someone you want to spend time with that person, right?

**Activity suggestion:** Go for a picnic today, but instead of taking a basket of food, take your Children's Bible. Lay out a blanket on the floor or in the yard and read God's Word. If you can't read yet, ask a family member to join in and read to you!



# E IS FOR EXCELLENT.

***The Lord is GREAT, worthy of ALL your praise!  
Sing Songs about His WONDERFUL name,  
ALL of your days!***

“O LORD, our Lord, how excellent is  
Your name in all the earth!”

PSALM 8:1

**Devotional:** To be excellent means to be great or the most high. God is the GREATEST and the MOST HIGH, inside and outside of the Universe. He is the reason everything exists and holds together. God is the reason that our lives have purpose. We know that He made us special and has given us talents and gifts to use to bring His name glory. So worship Him and sing songs to Him, because God is EXCELLENT and worthy of all our praise!

**Activity Suggestion:** Spend some time singing songs to the Lord. The Bible tells us to make a joyful noise, so have some fun singing, clapping and lifting up your hands to our EXCELLENT God! A few classic song ideas: “Jesus Loves Me,” “Our God is an Awesome God,” “The B-I-B-L-E,” and “My God is So Big (So Strong and So Mighty).”



# F IS FOR FAITHFUL FATHER.


***God will never leave you or never let you down.  
You can trust Him to stay and always be around.***

“The LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments.”

DEUTERONOMY 7:9

**Devotional:** God is a faithful father who loves you and will never leave you. You can talk to Him anywhere, anytime in prayer, and He is always listening. You don't have to be scared of bad dreams at night or afraid of walking into a new classroom full of kids you don't know, because no matter where you go, God is always faithful to go with you. You can see over and over again in the Bible that God is faithful to take care of His people. God kept Noah's family safe from the flood, He shut the lion's mouths when Daniel was thrown in the lion's den, He kept baby Moses safe as he floated down the Nile River in a basket, and He is faithful to take care of you too!

**Activity Suggestion:** When you lay your head down tonight, pray and ask God to replace any worries you have with His peace. He is faithful, so when you ask Him to do something, TRUST that He will do it! It doesn't mean all the hard things will go away, but this is the faithfulness of God, that He will help you and be with you no matter what. You can lay your head down and sleep without worry.



# G IS FOR GRACE GIVER.

***God gives us grace and mercy as a gift, not because of something you do. He sent his son Jesus to forgive our sins, because He loves you.***

“For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God.”

EPHESIANS 2:8

**Devotional:** The grace that God gives you cannot be earned. You can't use money to buy it or do something special to get it. God's grace is a gift, and it is completely free. The only thing you have to do is receive it. For example, when you get a birthday present, you take it, open it, and it's yours, right? You don't ask how much it cost or what you have to do to keep it, because it's yours. God's grace is like that. He gives you his grace every day in the way He forgives and loves you, even when you don't deserve it.

**Activity Suggestion:** Do something unexpected today for each person in your family. Forgive your brother or sister quickly, help your mom make dinner, or write a thank you note to your dad for all his hard work. If they ask you why, just say it's a free gift because you love them.
